



## Directions from Cape Town:

- Head out of Cape Town on the N1 North.
- After about 40km, take the R44 towards Wellington (exit 47)
- Stay on the R44 for 23km until you reach a set of traffic lights just before Wellington. Turn Left.
- Stay on this road for 78km past Hermon and Gouda, through Nuwekloof Pass and through Michell's Pass until you reach Ceres.
- Turn left at the second set of traffic lights.
- Drive for about 10km to Prince Alfred's Hamlet.
- Continue through Prince Alfred's Hamlet.
- After about 2km you will see the At Source Handmade Foods factory on your right with a prominent *Cecilia's Farm* sign on it.
  - If you want to visit the *Cecilia's Farm Shop*, turn off here.
  - For the Koelfontein Estate Head Office, also turn off here and follow the signs.
  - For *Die Kloof* self-catering guest house, continue north on the R303 for a further 800m. The gate to *Die Kloof* is on the left.
  - For *Die Kelder*, Koelfontein's wine tasting venue, continue north on the R303 for a further 1.3km. The turnoff is on the right. Follow the signs from here to *Die Kelder*.

**Duration:** 2 hours, ±160km

### GPS coordinates:

- Turnoff to *Die Kloof* self-catering cottage: S 33° 15' 33.0" E 19° 19' 32.1"
- Turnoff to *Die Kelder* wine tasting room: S 33° 15' 17.6" E 19° 19' 40.9"

### Please note:

Your GPS may direct you over Bain's Kloof Pass to get to us as it is the most direct route. While this is a gorgeously scenic drive, it is also quite precarious and takes longer due to the narrow and winding nature of the pass. If you're not feeling adventurous, we recommend taking the route described above via Nuwekloof Pass.
